How often do you think we should eat sweets?



This week I have some throwing and catching tasks. There are lots of variations so there will be one that suits. If you have access to different balls that is great but rolled up socks will work, and balloons are great too.

- Throwing a ball into a tub, try different ways of throwing (overarm, underarm etc). Concentrate on turn taking.
- Passing a ball hand to hand, like juggling a single ball.
- Rolling a ball around your body or get your child to lie down and roll the ball along their body.
