The following are suggestions for all learners so will need to be adapted or ignored as appropriate.

- Choose a topic and research it on the internet
- Look at a map of Scotland and find the following places: Edinburgh, Glasgow, Wishaw, Inverness, Aberdeen
- Continue with your diary
- Write or type a story (ask an adult to scribe for you, if necessary) about a hobby or something that you like to do
- Make a video of something that interests you
- Listen to stories read to you or on YouTube
- Type familiar words on the computer
- Practise changing the font and font size
- Find a picture on the internet and copy and paste it into your document
- Play I Spy, practising initial letter sounds
- Find objects/words that begin with different letters
- Find letters or words in a magazine and make your name/ a collage with letters or numbers
- Follow or give each other instructions to follow
- Play yes/no games
- Give me (an object), give e.g. the cup to Mum

- Play board games - use 2 dice - practise adding two together, counting on
- Recognising dice patterns
- Double numbers
- Count objects on the table, add another one, how many now?
- Count objects, take 1 away, how many now?
- Count to 20
- Practise the number before/number after
- Practise colours - making sets of the same colour and being able to say the name of the colour
