<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Signalong</u></p> <p>Our SLT team have created a bear hunt symbol board:</p> <p>https://braidburnedinburgh.files.wordpress.com/2020/04/bear-hunt-language-board.pdf</p> <p>Can you use these symbols at the right time when reading the story?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Number hunt</u></p> <p>Go on a number hunt around your house. If you can, take pictures of the numbers (or write them down) and then order them.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Story</u></p> <p>Watch 'We're Going on a Bear Hunt' animated story/read the book at home.</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=0gyl6ykDwds</p> <p>Design a teddy bear. What would your bear be called? What clothes would it wear? What adventures would it go on? Can you think of any other questions?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Rhymes</u></p> <p>Can you listen to and learn a new poem or nursery rhyme? Can you tell it to someone else so that they can do it? There are lots of different poems and rhymes online – can you find a favourite?</p>
<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Den Building?</u></p> <p>Create your own indoor/outdoor den. It could be anything you want it to be e.g. a cave, castle, tent etc. Who lives in your den? What is it made of? Perhaps you could take a picture of it or make a drawing of it?</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><u>Letter/Picture</u></p> <p>Can you write a letter or draw a picture for someone you haven't seen in a long time? What things would they like to know? What do you miss about not seeing them? Perhaps you could post it to brighten up their day?</p>

Birdwatch:

Look around for some different types of birds. How many different kinds can you see? I have pigeons and blue tits that regularly visit my garden for food – do you have any birds that you see a lot of? Why not draw a picture of your favourite bird or find out some fun facts using the internet?

Try -Rhyming name song.

There are a few examples to help. Try making your own and find rhymes for all the names in your household. This could be continued to favourite colours. Ex, Pete likes Red....Its the colour of his bed.

Ukulele - Ho Hey music and video uploaded onto school website.

HE - Tzatziki on website.

PE - Try a short fitness circuit: Choose 5 exercises (sit ups, star jumps, sit to stand with a chair, stretching arms up above head, reaching ear to shoulder, touching toes etc), do each exercise for 30s and rest for 30s. If this is easy try and do the whole circuit a few times through.

You could also do this with a dice to make it more unpredictable: For each of you 5 exercises roll the dice, the number rolled is the number of repetitions you do of the exercise.
