The following are suggestions for all learners so will need to be adapted or ignored as appropriate.

- Our word of the week is **friendship**
  - Look at the word, cover it and see if you can spell it
  - Draw a picture of a very good friend. Tell someone about your friend or write about them
  - Find words that rhyme with mop, bag, bin, cup. Can you draw pictures?
  - Play a game. Can you name:
    - 5 animals
    - 5 toys
    - 5 items of clothing
    - 5 foods (carbohydrates, Isabella!)You can play with your family. You can time yourselves. Have fun!
  - Look at the word **computer**. How many words can you make from that word? I will start you off - to, rut... Can you make 20? 30?
  - Retell a story in your own words
  - Take photographs and make a scrapbook
  - Continue with your diary
  - Practise saying, writing/typing your full name, age, date of birth, address, postcode and telephone number
  - Hide objects and give clues for others to find them, on/under/in
  - Watch Newsround
  - Read a book, listen to a story
  - Count in ones, twos, fives and tens. Count forwards and backwards
  - Share a set of everyday items into equal sets - 12 biscuits shared equally between 4 plates

- You can work on timing things or counting repetitions of actions using a stopwatch (or just counting seconds) e.g.:  
How many hops can you do without falling over? How many catches of a ball can you do without dropping it? How long can you keep a book balanced on your head? How long does it take you to stack 10 bricks or stones from your garden/walk?
- Learn some banking words - debit card, PayPal, direct debit, interest, pin, bank statement, utility bill
