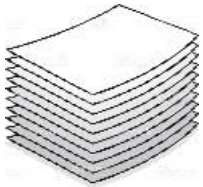
The Loch Ness Monster



Make a picture of the loch ness monster swimming in Loch Ness.

Materials you may need:

Paper



Paint



Paintbrush



Scissors or craft knife



Optional

Googly eyes



Sponge



Cut newspaper or old magazine into shapes like the image above to fit your sheet of white paper.



Paint your paper blue and add a little white to look like clouds and white frothy water.

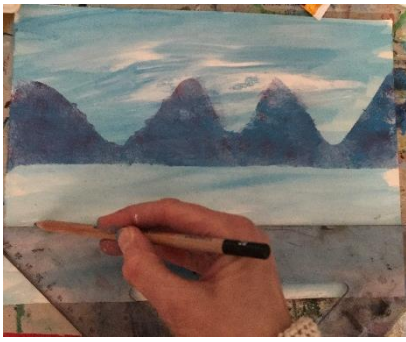


Place newspaper onto your painted blue paper and sponge a darker blue all over exposed area.



Remove the newspaper or magazine to reveal your sky, mountains, and sea.





Draw a line in a little from the edge, halfway across the Sea, and stop before you reach the other end!

Using a craft knife or scissors, cut along the pencil line.

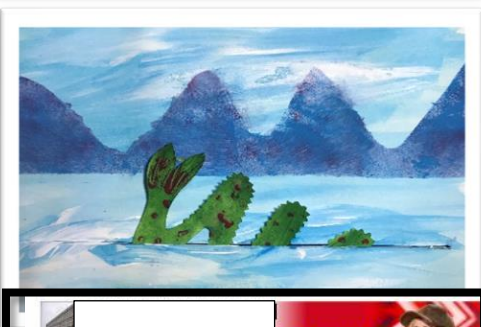
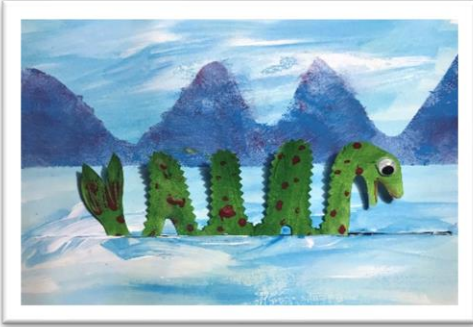
Add some white paint over the cut to make it look like water splashing!



The Monster!
 What will your monster look like? I used crimping scissors to give my monster a jaggy back! I painted him green then added dots of red using the end of my brush dipped into the paint. I added a googly eye, you can just draw or paint an eye on if you like.



Slip your Loch Ness monster through the slit in your painting, make him swim up to the surface and back down below. Take some photos of your monster swimming in the Loch. Amaze your family and friends!
